A FESTIVAL CONCERT: Our annual Festival Concert will take place at Macomb Center for the Performing Arts, Tuesday, February 23rd at 7pm, and will feature the Campus, Concert, and Symphonic Bands. *Love Speaks*, a symphony for band written by student Tyler Bouque, will be premiered in a performance dedicated to the Love family. Students will leave directly from school by bus, stop en route to purchase dinner, and arrive early at Macomb Center for a sound check/dress rehearsal. Students will need to check-in their complete concert band uniform before school on Monday, February 22nd, between 6:15 and 7am.

Tickets for the concert are \$10 each and may be ordered by returning this completed <u>Festival</u> <u>Concert Ticket Order Form</u> (checks payable to THBB) in an envelope marked "Festival Concert" to the black box in the band room by Wednesday, February 17th. Tickets will be sent home with students by Friday, February 19th. Tickets may also be purchased at the door of the Macomb Center on the evening of the performance.
