Dear Band Parents,

"SOUNDS OF THE SEASON" – Allow the student musicians of the Troy Colt Bands to usher in the joy of the season at our annual Winter Concert, on **Thursday, December 5th** at 7pm in the THS auditorium. The Campus, Cadet, Concert, Symphonic and Jazz Bands as well as the Percussion Ensemble will present music to suit all tastes.
