The winter months are a great time to support and enjoy the Troy Colt Bands with their many upcoming performances!

MSBOA District 16 Chamber & Solo & Ensemble Festivals - Over the course of three days, many of our student musicians performed in MSBOA District Solo/Ensemble events at Rochester High School. These events included six honors chamber groups, three large percussion ensembles and over one hundred solos and small ensembles. Students received incredible feedback from professional adjudicators and gained valuable performance experience. Congratulations to all members of our Troy Colt Bands who participated!

**St. Olaf College Band Concert** - We are excited to announce that we will be hosting the renowned St. Olaf Band for a special concert on **Sunday, February 4<sup>th</sup> at 3pm** in the Troy High Auditorium. **A Festival Concert** - Our annual Festival Concert will take place at Macomb Center for the Performing Arts, Thursday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm. Tickets for the concert are \$10 in advance and may be ordered online here: Festival Concert Pre Order Tickets, or by returning the attached order form with payment (cash or checks payable to THBB) in an envelope marked "Festival Concert" to the black box in the band room by Friday, February 16th. Tickets will be sent home in a red envelope with students on Wednesday, February 21st.

Students are required to check-in their complete concert band uniform before school on Wednesday, February 21st, between 6:15 and 7am for this concert. Please make sure the following items are in your child's garment bag: Girls- hair tie, and black nylons. Boys- black calf length socks.

Students will be transported (by school bus) directly after school to the Macomb Center for a catered dinner and their pre-concert dress rehearsal/sound check. For ease and convenience, the Band Boosters have secured a catered dinner for all students that will be served at the Macomb Center prior to sound checks. Students are required to pay \$15 in advance to the black box in the band room by February 14<sup>th</sup> for this extensive pasta and salad buffet. We have taken great care to ensure that all dietary needs will be met with this catered meal. No outside food and beverages will be allowed for dinner at this event.

**NOTE**: No transportation will be provided after the concert back to the school, so please make arrangements for your student's return at the end of the event.
